Follow up seminar to 'The Future of Spiritual Care in Health'

The first Twilight Seminar for 2018, held April 11, workshopped responses to the series of questions raised by Spiritual Health Victoria CEO, Cheryl Holmes, in her presentation entitled, *The Future of Spiritual Care in Health*, delivered at the University of Divinity professional development day in October 2017.

The resultant responses were collated into **the dot point summary attached to this invitation**, with a view to inviting Cheryl to engage with members of ASACPEV on these very important issues. Cheryl has accepted our invitation and will join us on Wednesday 29th August to explore together the points raised in her presentation and in ASACPEV's seminar/workshop.

A reminder of the questions being explored:

Cheryl asked:

- Are our current education pathways preparing the workforce that is needed for an increasingly complex health care environment?
- Is it ethical to use CPE students to provide care in complex health systems without adequate preparation and knowledge of the system and the place of spiritual care within it?
- As spiritual care is recognised as an allied health profession, can we continue with models of education that often seem more directed towards pastoral ministries than spiritual care in health?
- How can we develop education pathways that will provide a spiritual care workforce ready and able to meet the demands they will face and who are also able to speak into that complexity to point towards the humanity, dignity and value of each person struggling in and with the system?

All are welcome to participate in this seminar - attendance at the previous seminar is not a pre-requisite.
